



# Choosing The Right Scale Every Single Time!

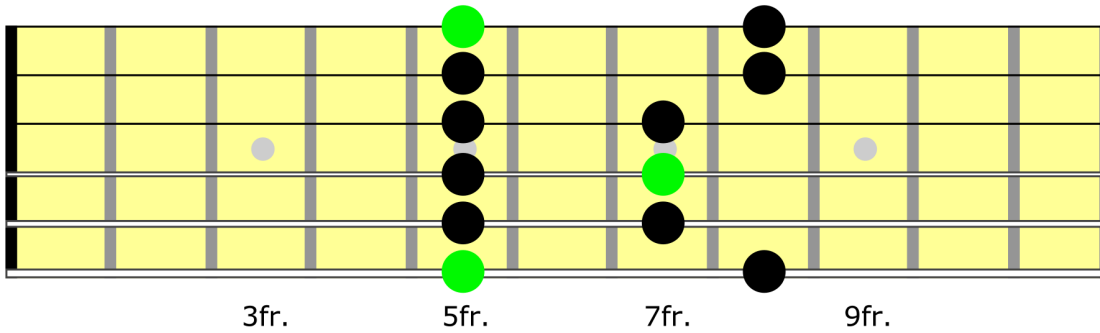

We go over some saucy scales in this lesson! Below are the diagrams for each of those scales in the key of A minor.

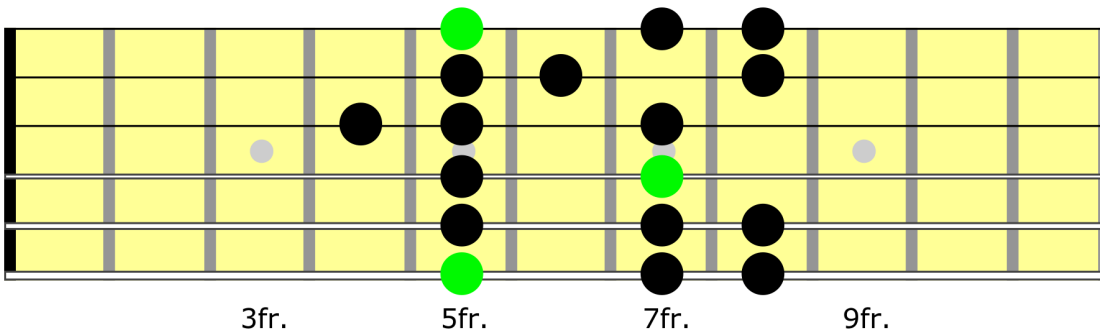
The green dots indicate the root note, which is "A". If you feel lost going through the notes in these scales, just default to playing one of those root notes as a safety net to fall back on.

\*Pro tip: Instead of going up and down these scales linearly, try playing a few notes at a time to craft musical "sentences" with. This way your soloing will immediately sound more musical than just exercising the scale up and down.

A Minor Pentatonic Scale

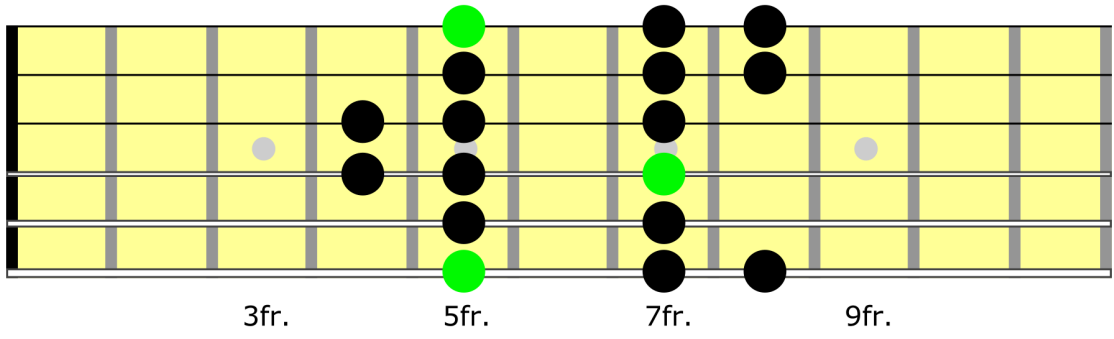


A Natural Minor Scale (aka the A Aeolian Scale)
