



The "Drunken Spider Walk"

The guitar tabs shown below represent how to perform the Drunken Spider Walk, but they don't show the "whole picture". Be sure to watch the video where I walk you through step-by-step on exactly how to perform this exercise. These tabs are only supplied as reference if you wanted to make sure you have the exercise down.

Also keep in mind that this exercise is essentially a pattern that can be repeated on all frets, not just those shown here in the tabs. Here's how it looks when starting from the 1st fret on your guitar, moving up:

Going Up
