



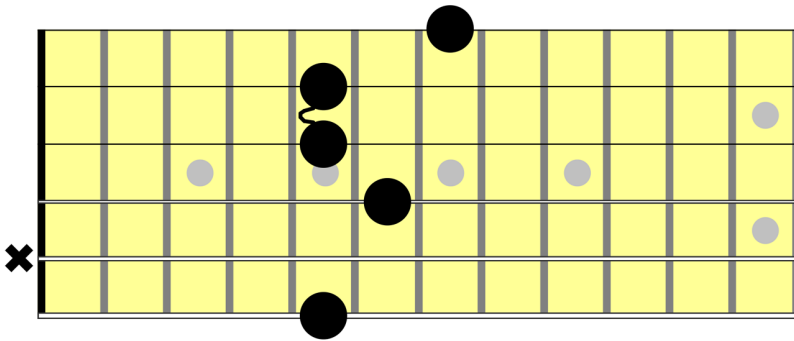
This Chord Will Silence A Crowd

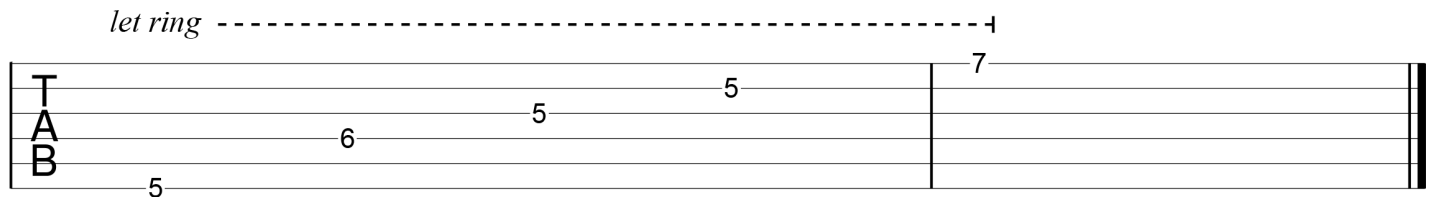
Here are two ways you can read the min/Maj7add9 chord on paper. These examples will be in the key of A minor.

How it looks on a fretboard diagram:

Minor/Major 7 add 9 Chord Shape (Here positioned to be Amin/Maj7 add9)



And here's how it'll look in tablature, broken up in an arpeggio:



This chord is a great choice to end a phrase in a minor key. But have fun with this and try it in different ways to discover its uses!
